Installing a JDBC Driver and Creating a Connection Pool

Perform the following steps to install a JDBC Driver in Ambience.

This document uses the SQL JDBC Driver as an example.

Notes:

- Steps 1 to 5 are for driver installation.
- Steps 6 to 10 are for creating a new connection pool using the installed driver.
- 1. Place the JDBC driver in the **/ElixirAmbience/lib** folder.
- 2. Restart Ambience server to load the JAR file.
- 3. Log in as **admin** to enable the driver.
- 4. Click **Admin --> Drivers**.
- 5. Find the driver name and tick the box to enable it accordingly.
- 6. Start Ambience Designer.
- 7. Select to a folder in the folder tree on the left hand pane. Right click and select **Add** --> **Connection Pool**.
- 8. Input the name of the connection pool.
- 9. Choose the driver.
- 10. Input the URL, User and Password before testing and saving the connection.
